

Nancy Jo Tutino Past Grand Matron 1994-1995



Nancy Jo Tutino was initiated into Home Chapter No. 193 on January 7, 1964, subsequently demitting from Home Chapter and affiliating with Pyramid Chapter No. 257 where she served as Worthy Matron in 1974-75 and in 2003-04. She served as a Deputy Instructor in 1976-77.

On September 17, 1979 she became a dual member of Faith Chapter No. 255 where she served as Worthy Matron in 1982-83. On November 13, 1985 she also became a dual member of Amethyst Chapter No. 138 where she served as Worthy Matron in 1989-90 and in 1996-97.

She was a Life Member of both Pyramid and

Amethyst Chapters.

In 1986 she was selected to serve as Grand Adah in the Wheatheart Grand Family with WGM Kay Smith and WGP Charlie Shafer.

On June 25, 1994 Sister Nancy Jo was elevated to the position of Worthy Grand Matron with Robert Herman serving at her side as Worthy Grand Patron. In her Worthy Grand Matron Report given at her 'Circus of Stars' Session she reported that 'My dreams have been fulfilled – for my dream was to honor the Lord through service to you, the membership of the Grand Chapter of Washington.'

Sister Nancy Jo Tutino was born May 11, 1944 in Seattle and passed away December 31, 2008. She leaves her husband of 30 years, Louis Tutino Sr., seven children, 15 grandchildren and three great-grandchildren. Services were held January 10, 2009 at the First Presbyterian Church in Ellensburg.
