

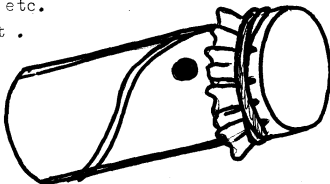
MEETINGS CAN BE FUN

MAKE A KAZOO _____ MAKE LOTS OF " KAZOO'S"

1. A Kazoo is a real musical instrument.
2. It can be played instantly.
3. Only talent needed is to sing a tune in do-do-do or do-do-doodle-oodle-do etc.
4. It will fit in your Pocket .

MATERIALS NEEDED:

Paper tube
Wax paper
Rubber band
Pencil or paper punch



CONSTRUCTION :

Paper tubes, any size. Paper towel and toilet Paper roll tubes work fine. Cut a piece of wax paper a few inches wider than tube opening. Wrap wax paper around one open end of the tube, smooth and tight and hold in place with rubber band. At same end of tube, about 1 inch from the end, punch a hole about as round as a pencil.

NOW PLAY - Hold open end of the Kazoo around the outside of your mouth, Pucker your lips and begin singing or humming a song in do's, do-do-doodle- oodle etc. Keep going with songs everyone knows. Have a Kazoo Jam Session. Try " Kazooing " along with the piano or radio.

Use your imagination - Provide your own chapter intertainment. Even the shy will join in the fun. Form a Kazoo Band. They could play for a "dance troupe" or as part of an addenda.
