

Some Meeting Fun

Art Contest – Give out slips of paper and pencil. Members draw the picture of the member on his left. Write name of drawing and who drew it on the back. Put up for judging and display.

Telegrams - Given blanks with letters: h h m h a a a t o r l c - write telegrams beginning with each letter to make a word consecutively. Sample: "Have Henry Miller handle all assets and take out reasonable insurance coverage." Or "Hurry home, Mary had auto. Accident and the old rooster is crowing." Collect and read them.

Hidden animal crackers or eggs – hide them all over the room. Prizes given by color or number found.

Birthday Flowers – Give a bouquet to person(s) who has a birthday on the meeting date.

Christmas Toy – Pin on back of each member the name of some toy. Like: jumping jack, electric train, doll, woolly dog, etc. Members can only ask a question that will answer "yes" or "no". Pin it to your front when you have guessed it and retire from the game.

Jig-Saw Sentences – write facts on paper and cut them up. Have members assemble them then read them out loud.

Month of the Year – Use the month of the year as a subject. "These April days...." Select a number event in history of the world that took place in April on that meeting date. Add club history.

Nursery Rhymes – list as many as you know.

April 1st – announce that there is a 5 lb. bag of peanuts hidden somewhere about the room. After 2 or 3 minutes say "April Fool!"

OES – write words for each of the letters spelled out in the name.

Long Word – reverse for last letter of word for first letter of word. One point for each letter between each letter between words.
