Addenda for Grand Worthy Matron, Dolores Moore:
September 26, 1950

The marshalls of Naomi and Narcissus chapters march in leading the Star Points of each chapter and form a semicircle behind the Labyrinth. The marshalls come to the East, one from each side, and say their pieces. Then in groups of two, the star points come forward, one from each side, and say their pieces, each group then presenting the Grand Worthy Matron with red roses. The last two points, Electa, present the bow for the bouquet and the card containing the gift.
