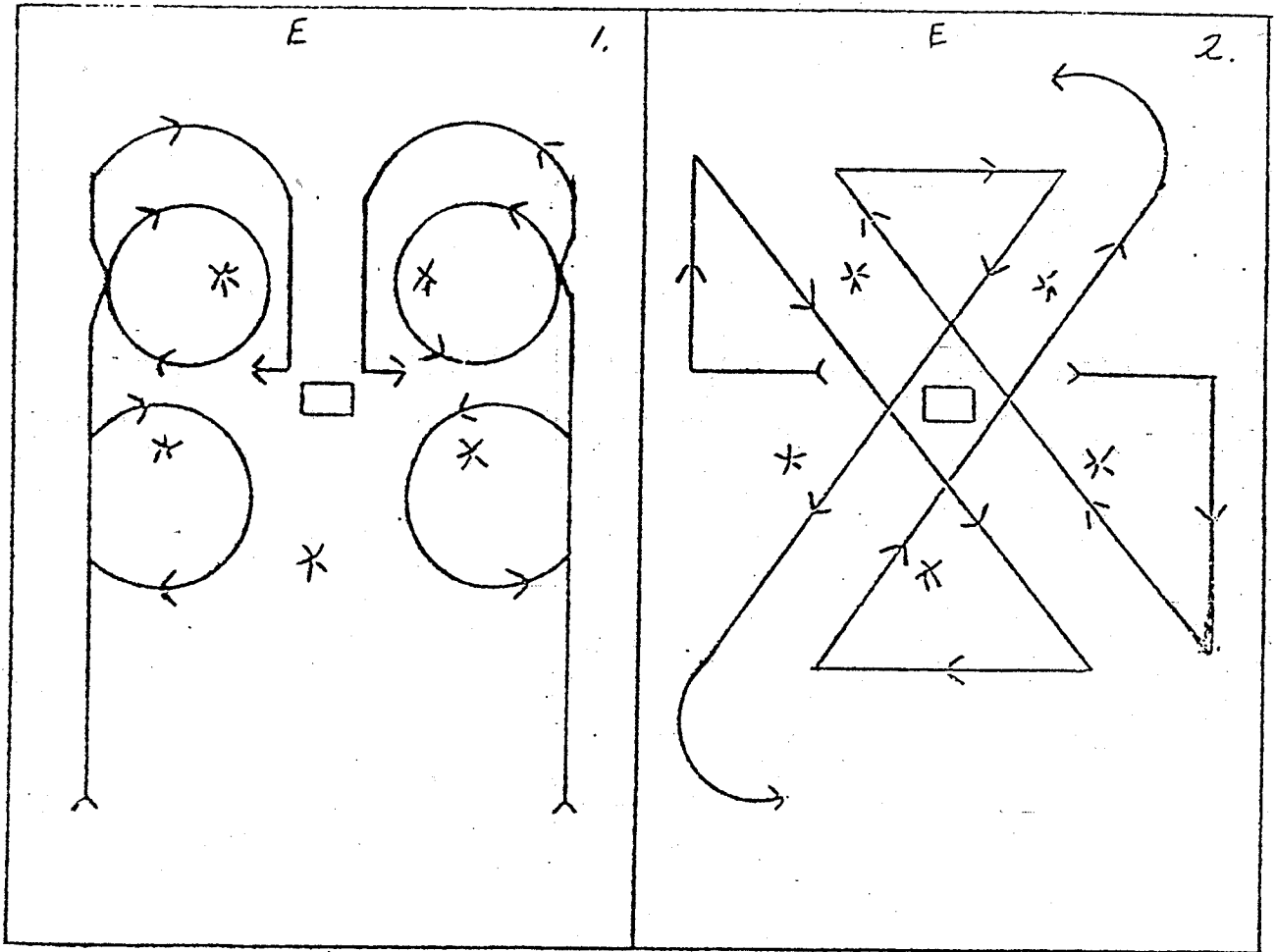
PROGRAM

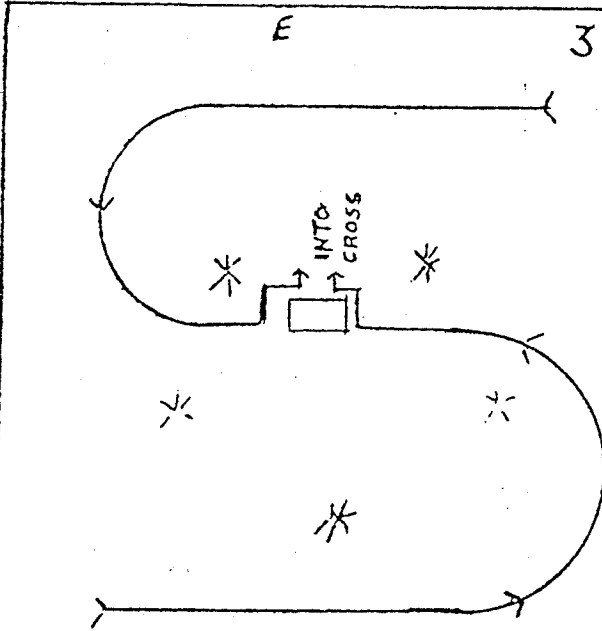
Officers line up in ante rooms in formation required in ritual. Conductress leads one line and Associate Conductress the other.

In figure 1 all officers enter and march East. When the stations of Martha and Ruth are reached by Adah and Electa, and all in line behind them, circle these chairs then continue to march East, falling in behind the group they left.

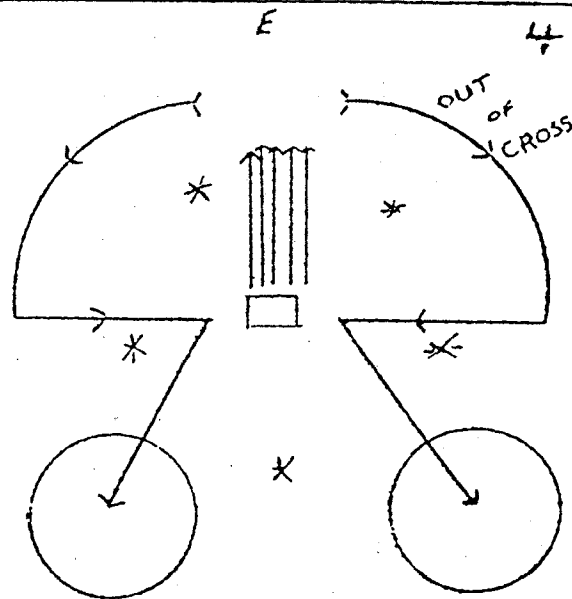
In the meantime the first part of the lines have circled Adah and Electa's chairs respectively.

All led by Conductress and Associate Conductress then march in one line from the East to Altar where they go into figure 2.





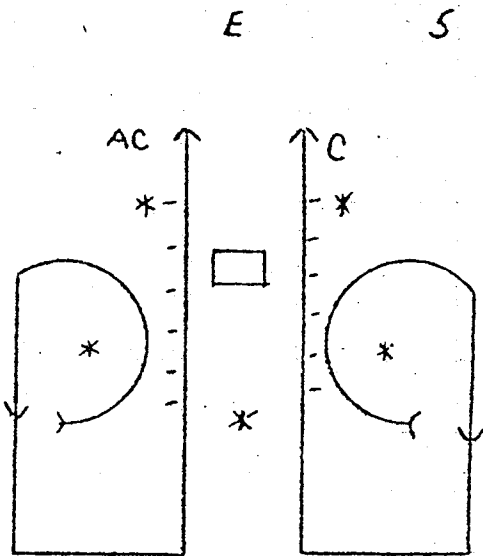
As Cond. reaches East center of Altar she faces East. A.C. steps in behind her followed by Sec. and Treas. alternately. As Treas. faces East Martha and Adah face East on her right and Chaplain and Electa on her left; all march East. This forms arms of the cross. Behind Treas. single file come Ruth, Martha, Warder, Esther, W.M. and A.M. In breaking cross Cond. leads South and A.C. North alternately.



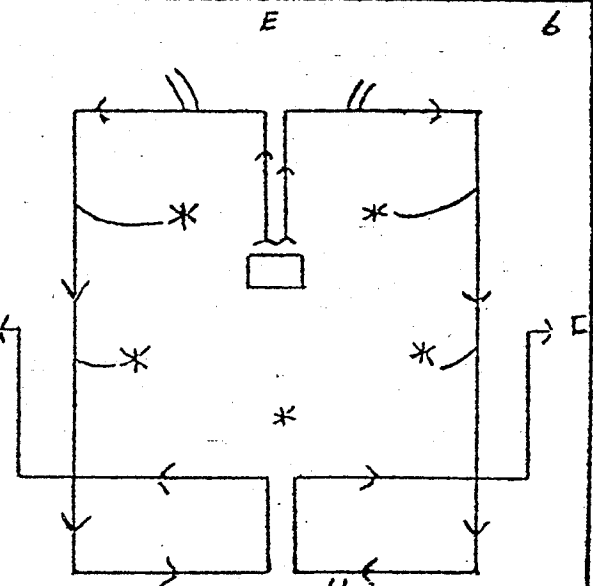
While officers stand cross formation, one verse of "The Old Rugged Cross" is sung.

A.C. steps into circle. Treas. leads in circle. A.C. leaves between Treas. and A.M.

Cond. steps into circle. Sec. leads line around circle. Cond. leaves circle between Sec. and W.M.

Officers drop off as stations passed
